Reservation and Payment

Reserve your place for "YOU at KU" by mailing or faxing the attached reservation form, OR submit your reservation online at <http://www2.ku.edu/~issfacts/prospective/orientation/>.

Pay by **Wednesday, December 2** and receive a **\$10 Early-Pay Bonus Discount**. You can pay online when you sign up, or with U.S. or international money order; cashier's check (with an American bank address on it), or a personal check from an American bank, made payable in U.S. dollars to "The University of Kansas" if you mail your reservation. There is a 6% service fee added for online payment. Sorry, no refunds if you decide not to attend.

Arrival and Registration

Registration for "YOU at KU" is **1:00 - 5:00 p.m., Sunday, January 9 at McCollum Hall** (1800 Engel Road). If you arrive late, register at the International Student & Scholar Services Office, Room 2 Strong Hall, Mon-Fri, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

At registration you will get your nametag, schedule and welcome packet. If you did not prepay, you will also pay your reservation fee in cash, by U.S. or international money order, cashier's check (with an American bank address), or a personal check from an American bank. See the Pre-Arrival Guide for suggestions on transportation from the Kansas City airport to Lawrence.

Make sure you bring your immigration documents (passport, visa, I-94, I-20/DS-2019, any other documents that verify your status).

Housing

There is no official housing for spring "YOU at KU" participants. Students who have submitted a spring contract and deposit to the Department of Student Housing for **McCollum Hall** or **Jayhawker Towers** can move in to their housing as soon as their room is available. If you have applied for Stouffer Place apartments, your move-in date is on your contract. Students who will live in the other residence halls may be able to move into their permanent room early. E-mail housing@ku.edu after December 19 to find out more information on moving in early. There is an extra charge for early move-in that will be billed to your KU account. This nightly rate pays for your room only, not meals. Beds, desks and dressers are provided, but you need to have your own towels, blankets, sheets and pillows.

If you do need off-campus housing during orientation, the **Rodeway Inn**, at 2525 W. 6 St. (785-841-8410), and the **Quality Inn** at 801 Iowa St. (785-842-5100) have offered special prices for "YOU at KU" participants. Prices range per night from \$40-45 per single room, and \$45-50 per double room. Be sure to say you are with New International Student Orientation.
